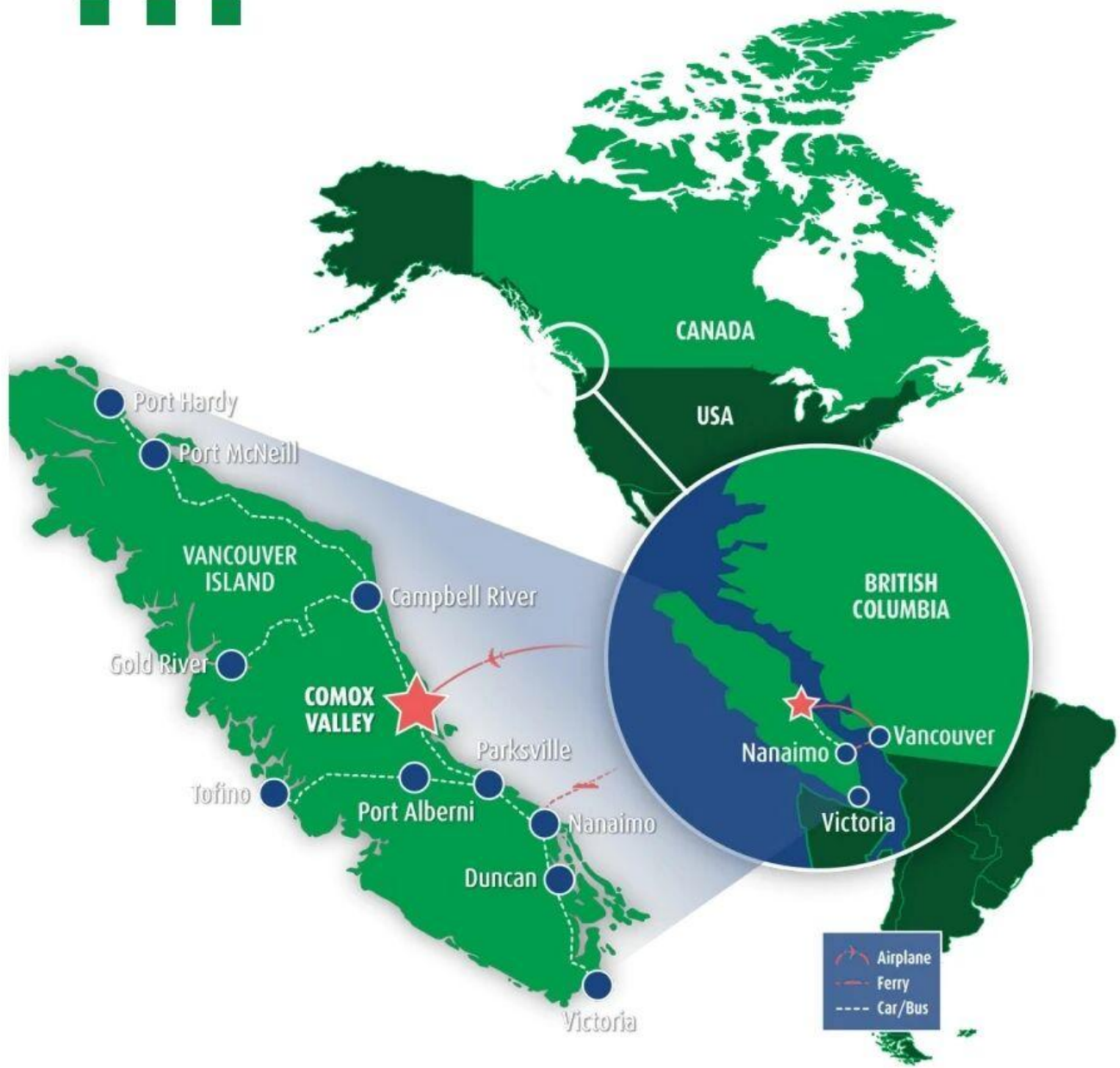

Explore the beautiful hiking trails and orienteering courses nearby to get close to nature.

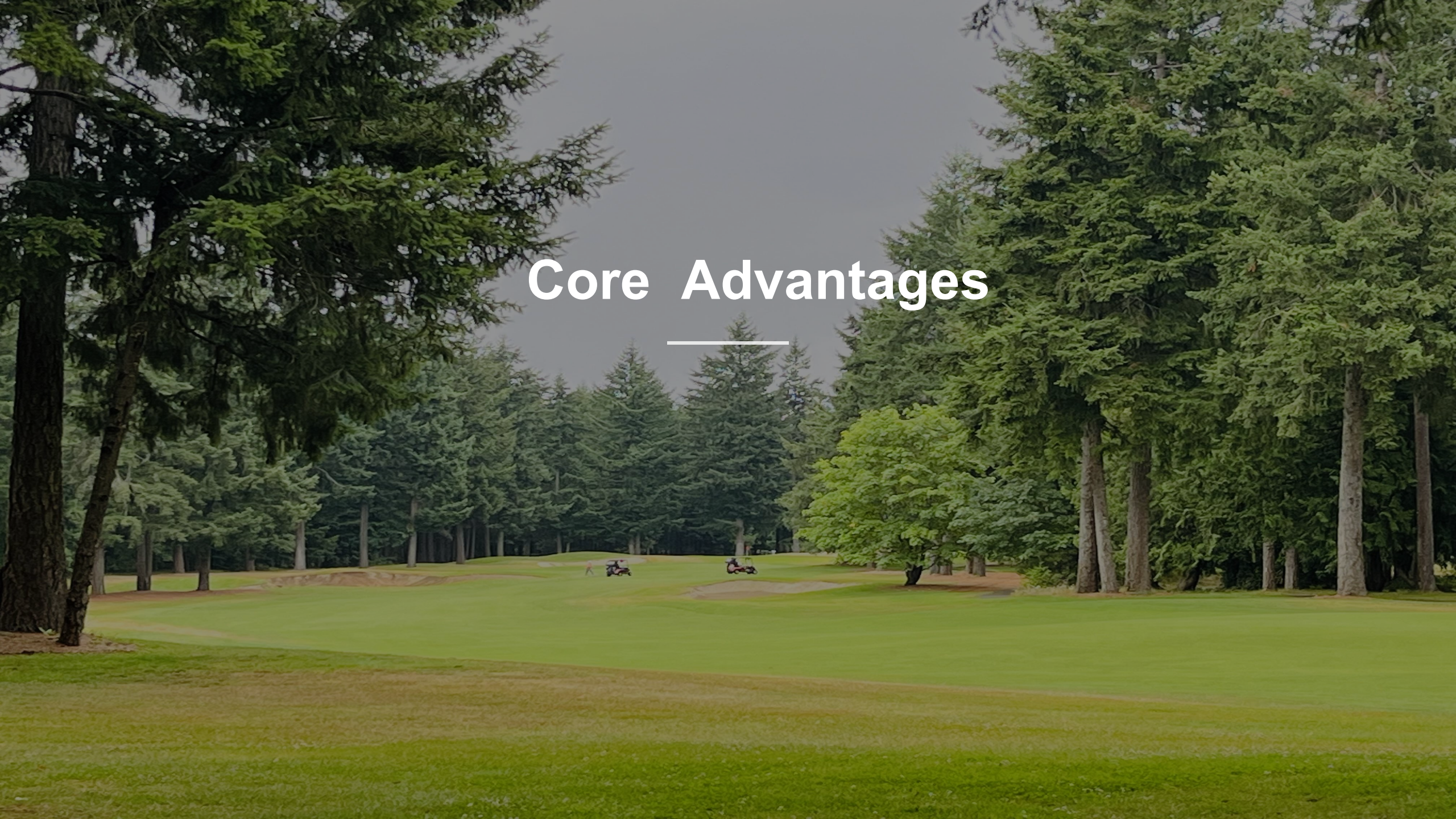

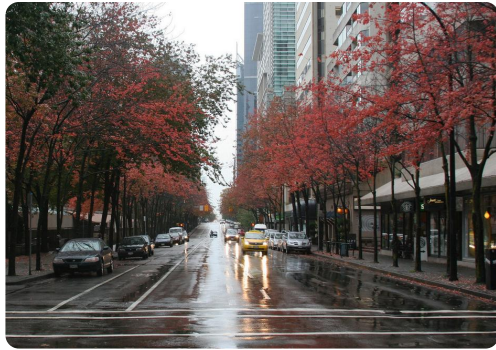




Activity Schedule
