Deferring Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Scholarship is non-transferable, and the term of study cannot be deferred. Should a student withdraw, 100% tuition plus registration fee will be owed to the school. The scholarship will be terminated and cashing out for the remaining value of the scholarship is not permitted

Academic Minimum Requirements for Students entering Grade 9 of the Middle Years Programme at ISNS

- A total score of at least 45/56 points overall from the 8 subject groups
- No behavior or academic misconduct issues
- If coming from a non-IB school, an expected average of 85% or above, or grade of A or above in all their current subjects, as well as a letter of recommendation from a current teacher or Administrator

Academic Minimum Requirements for Students entering Grade 10 of the Middle Years Programme at ISNS

- A total score of at least 45/56 points overall from the 8 subject groups
- No behavior or academic misconduct issues
- Successful completion of the Grade 9 Community Project, with a strong demonstration of the ATL's, determined by the discretion of the scholarship committee, and that an authentic need in the community has been met
- If coming from a non-IB school, and expected average of 85% or above, or grade of A or above in all their current subjects, as well as a letter of recommendation from a current teacher or administrator
